



Colorado State Off-Highway Vehicle Program

The purpose of the Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Program is to improve and enhance OHV recreation opportunities throughout Colorado. Safe, responsible, recreation is emphasized while protecting and enhancing natural resources.

The State OHV Program is administered by Colorado State Parks and is funded through an annual OHV registration fee of \$25.25. These registration fees are used for the funding of motorized trail projects including trail maintenance, construction, facilities, land purchases, right-of-ways leases, maps, safety and visitor information. The OHV Registration program began in 1990 with 11,744 OHV's registered and has increased to over 134,000 OHV registrations last year.

The State OHV Program has formed cooperative partnerships with the US Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, State Agencies, motorized clubs and the Colorado Off-Highway Vehicle Coalition to enhance and create OHV recreation opportunities statewide. Since the program has started, over 400 projects have been funded for over \$14 million.
